The Short History of Our Class

The past six years were a long time for us, but a time to remember also. The University career of the class began in the ancient city of Sopron at the foothills of the Alps at the 1st of September 1953. The students who came from all over the country began to love this beautiful and historically, rich town and the Alma Mater from the first moment on. The ordinary week days and holidays brought close ties into our little society. The boys spent the July of 1954 in a military camp near Hajduhadhaza. We continued our studies in fall of 1954 without the intended partition of the class into purely engineering and a purely forestry section. At the end of that term we attended a field trip. The boys served again in the army at Nagykoros in the summer of 1955. The class finished its third academic year in May of 1956. After that the students worked as practicians in the forest or forest industry. Our fourth year was interrupted by known historical events. Through Vienna, Salzburg, Calais, Dover, London, Liverpool, St. John., Montreal and Winnipeg our way led to Vancouver. We began our fourth year for the second time at the U.B.C. here in Vancouver. After the first university year at U.B.C. came a six months long period of summer work. At November 1st, 1958 our last term started and in April 1959 we shall get our diplomas the result of six years of hard work. At the time of our graduation, we think with very much love, of those who helped us to achieve this goal. We think of our parents and professors who educated us with great devotion during these six long years. They wanted us to become good foresters as well as good citizens. With all the warmth of our hearts we remember the dear friends at home: we shall carry their memory in our hearts forever.
