The professors and assistants' standpoints referring the Canadian offer.

The Faculty of Forestry of the University of Sopron accepted with thanks the invitation of the Canadian Minister of Immigration and the British Columbia University.

We wish to assure the activity of our Faculty according to the followings:

I. Teaching.

- 1./ We request full autonomy for our Faculty. We wish to prepare the course of instruction such a way that our forestry-ingenieurs should correspond both the demands of the Hungarian and the Canadian conditions.
- 2./ With your consent we should like to start the lectures in Hungarian language in September 1957, but the English language would be a compulsory subject. The diploms / graduation/ given to the students of forestry should be equivalent to those given to the Canadian students.
- 3./ We should like a building in a town or city for our University, supplied with library, with laboratories and all the necessary technical installations.
- 4./ We request to assure the expenses of returning to Hungary for those professors and students, who wish to return to the free independent and democratic Hungary.
- 5./ The professors and students regard learning English and study forestry of Canada their main task and thus prepare for the first term beginning at autumn 1957. We need for these purposes few interpreters so long as the professors and assistant teachers do not learn efficiently English.
- 6./ We request some Canadian professors to hold lectures in special subjects in our University and please assure the necessary money for them.
- 7./ We ask to make possible for those professors, assistants, students and family members, who can join the University only later, to come after us. Please assure the necessary financial basis for their journey.

II. Supply.

- 1./ Please arrange our life on such a way that the main task of the professors be cultivating their own branch, and that of the students should be learning. Please assure our salaries on such a way that these should give us enough stimulation to achieve our scientific-branch.
- 2./ We ask for a salary for the professors and assistants after the arrival to Canada. Please take in consideration at the fixing of our salary the financial situation of the professors

and assistants of the Columbia University. Please inform us about their salaries.

- 3./ We ask for such scholarships for the students that they should be able to continue their studies without troubles. / The refugee University students in European countries receive \$ 50-60 scholarship monthly.
- 4./ We ask for lodgings for the professors and assistants to live together with their families. Please kindly give the students corresponding abode.

III. Future of the professors and assistants.

After the graduation of all the students, please give us chance to continue our research-work, or to find job in plants.

Please kindly reply to each of our points in writing, thus that we should have enough time to make a final agreement, which satisfies us both.
